COOKIES AND SIMILAR TECHNOLOGIES

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that is stored by the computer when a website is visited by a user. The text stores information that the site is able to read when it is consulted at a later time. Some of these cookies are necessary for the proper functioning of the site, others are useful to the visitor because they can safely store, for example, the user name or the language settings. The advantage of having cookies installed in your PC is that you no longer need to fill out the same information every time you want to access a website visited previously.

How do you consent the use of cookies?

The consent to the use of profiling cookies is provided by the user by clicking on the button **I ACCEPT COOKIES** or **ENABLE COOKIES** on the banner that appears at the bottom or top of the page, at the beginning and/or while browsing this site. It can be revoked at any time. All technical cookies do not require consent, so they are installed automatically as a result of access to the site. Not accepting the consent to the processing of data could lead to the site not being displayed correctly.

What cookies are present on this website?

TECHNICAL COOKIES

This type of cookie allows the correct operation of some sections of the site.

Persistent cookies: once the browser is closed they are not destroyed but remain until a pre-established expiry date.

Session cookies: they are destroyed every time the browser is closed. These cookies are necessary to view the site correctly and to use any technical services offered. Therefore, they will always be used and sent, unless the user changes the settings in his browser (but can prevent the full display of the site pages).

ANALYTICAL COOKIES

These cookies are used for anonymous statistical analysis in order to improve the use of the site and to make the content more interesting and relevant to the users. This type of cookie collects anonymous data on user activity. Analytical cookies can be sent from the site itself or from third-party domains.

How to revoke the consent to the use of cookies?
